### Ratified House Bill 564 Expands Voting Options In Jefferson County

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (04/12/2022): In the wake of recently-approved bipartisan election legislation, Jefferson County Clerk and Board of Elections Chairperson Bobbie Holsclaw today shared updates regarding how the laws will take effect in Jefferson County for the upcoming 2022 Primary Election.

“Providing voters with free, fair, and secure elections is a mission we’ve been proud to accomplish no matter the circumstances, and we’re already taking proactive steps to address these new directions,” said Bobbie Holsclaw, Jefferson County Clerk. “We feel confident the contents of House Bill 564 will continue to improve polling across the state, and now that the Governor has signed the bill, we are hard at work to put the law into practice.”

In accordance with both the newly-signed and previously-ratified election laws, eligible voters in Jefferson County can now participate in the primary and exercise their right to vote through:

- Excused Absentee Voting (for a full list of qualifications, [click here](#))
  - In-person
    - 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. | May 4, 5, 6, 9, 10, 11
    - Only at the Jefferson County Clerk's Office Election Center
      - 1000 E. Liberty Street, Louisville, KY 40204
  - By mail
    - The e-portal to request a mail-in ballot closes May 3. Please visit <https://vrsws.sos.ky.gov/ovrweb/govoteky> to begin the application process
